


The Philippines schools project

The canteen in the high school had a leaking roof, which had destroyed the ceiling. The roof had to come off



This revealed a wooden truss support, which was rotten. The only solution was to tear it all down and weld a new steel truss support.

Then we start to rebuild. The classroom also flood slightly in the wettest part of the year, so we make the decision to raise the floor and tile it.



Our solution is to replace rotted roof sheeting, and give everything a fresh coat of protective paint.





Then, add a new ceiling with improved materials that would not be subject to water ingress or infestation in the future


Floor raised and tiled, ceiling painted



Meanwhile, in the elementary school, the daycare centre was getting a little crowded. They asked if we could knock down a wall to increase the size of the classroom.

Of course we can. Then we arranged for a double sliding door to be fitted to maximise the available space.





We added glass sliding doors to maximise the space. Then we thought about making a play area outside of the classroom.

More of the new chairs in use


We painted a few of the classrooms to brighten them up
